

### Fun Facts about New Years around the world:

- 1. In some cities of Colombia, Cuba and Puerto Rico, there is a tradition of making a male doll that is stuffed with memories from the past year, all dressed with the clothes of the outgoing year and is called Mr. Old Year. At midnight, the doll is set on fire symbolizing erasing of the bad memories.
- 2. Mexicans are known to eat 12 grapes on New Year's Eve. They pop one each at the stroke of midnight, which symbolizes the nature of the months ahead. One needs to watch out in the month the grape tastes bitter! Pomegranates are eaten for prosperity while figs are for fertility.
- 3. In the annual Hogmany celebrations of Scotland, men swing blazing fireballs over their heads as they parade through the streets. The age old tradition is believed to bring a pure and sun-filled year.
- 4. Greeks in 600 B.C. began following a tradition of using a baby to signify the upcoming year. In order to celebrate their god of wine, Dionysus, people paraded a baby in a basket, representing annual rebirth of that god as the spirit of fertility.
- 5. In Italy people enjoy celebrating a few ancient traditions, like wearing red underwear. *Revellers* enjoy a dinner usually made with pig trotters and lentils, and a spoonful is eaten with every chime of the bell at midnight.
- 6. In Estonia, people believe that you should eat seven, nine or twelve times, on New Year's Eve, as these are lucky numbers.





### EYE ON WATER!

Welcome to Eye on Water!

Now you can view your water use in a few easy steps:

### Computer:

- 1. Visit https://eyeonwater.com on your computer using a supported web browser.
- 2. Click on the Create Account link.
- 3. Enter your service area Postal Cod: S0G 0Y0
- 4. Enter your billing account number: XXXX XXXX (8-digit number shown on water bill including the space).
- 5. Enter your email address.
- 6. Create and confirm a password.
- 7. You will get a confirmation email from BEACON. You must verify your email address by clicking this link. Once you do, you can sign in using your email and password.

### Phone App Instructions:

- 1. Go to the App store on your Android or IPhone and search for "Eye on Water".
- 2. Download the free App to your IPhone or Android Phone.
- 3. Open the App.
- 4. Tap on the Register Button.
- 5. Tap on "Enter your account information Manually".
- 6. Enter your Postal Code: S0G 0Y0
- 7. Select your water provider.
- 8. Enter your billing account number: XXXX XXXX (8-digit number shown on water bill including the space).
- 9. Tap on the 'next' button.
- 10. Enter a valid email address.
- 11. Create and confirm a password.
- 12. Verify that you have read the Terms of Service.
- 13. Tap on the 'next' button.
- 14. An email will be send to the address you provided.
- 15. Click or tap on the link in the email to verify it is valid.
- 16. You can now sign into your account.

If you have more than one account, please contact the Town Office and we can add the extra accounts to your EyeOnWater Account. Phone 306-723-4324

**NOTE**: To set up alerts for water usage – this has to be done on a computer. The App will not complete this task however, once it is set up on the computer your phone will receive the alerts.
