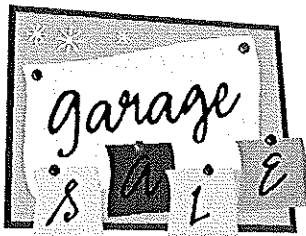
Other than where specified, all services will be located at the Cuppar Legion Hall, 217 Stanley Street until further notice.

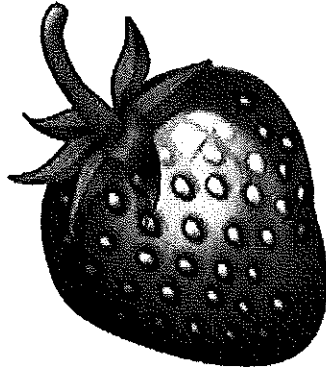
