It is far easier to keep the payments current than trying to catch up on bills that are months behind.

# Fire Dept...

A few Cold weather reminders from the Cupar Fire Department. Hopefully we will be seeing some warmer weather soon but until then please keep these tips in mind.....



- ✓ Keep anything that can burn at least three-feet away from heating equipment, like the furnace, fireplace, wood stove, or portable space heater.
- ✓ Have a three-foot "kid-free zone" around open fires and space heaters.
- ✓ Never use your oven to heat your home.
- ✓ Have a qualified professional install stationary space heating equipment, water heaters or central heating equipment according to the local codes and manufacturer's instructions.
- ✓ Have heating equipment and chimneys cleaned and inspected every year by a qualified professional.
- ✓ Remember to turn portable heaters off when leaving the room or going to bed.
- ✓ Always use the right kind of fuel, specified by the manufacturer, for fuel burning space heaters.
- ✓ Be sure all furnace controls and emergency shutoffs are in proper working condition.
- ✓ Leave furnace repairs to qualified trades people. Do not attempt repairs yourself unless you are qualified.
- ✓ Inspect the walls and ceiling near the furnace and along the chimney line. If the wall is hot or discoloured, additional pipe insulation or clearance may be required.
- ✓ Check the flue pipe and pipe seams. Are they well supported, free of holes, and cracks? Soot along or around seams may be an indicator of a leak. Have a CO2 detector on every level of you dwelling and near your sleeping area.
- ✓ Is the chimney solid, with cracks or loose bricks? All unused flue openings should be sealed with solid masonry.
- ✓ Keep trash and other combustibles away from the heating system.
