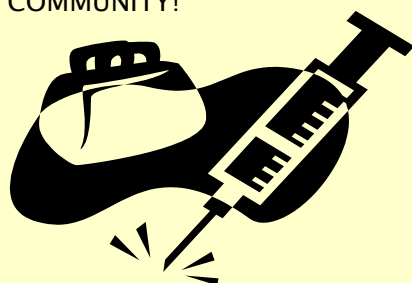
Welcome to Dr. Oluma!

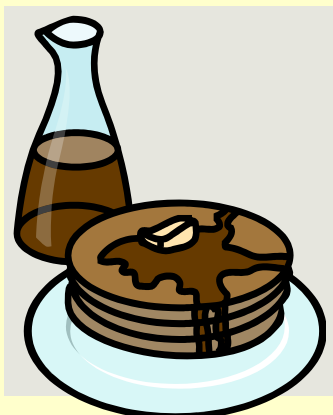
